Following the success of our first weekend in Bournemouth to celebrate our 10th Anniversary, we are organising our second weekend. We will be using the accommodation run by the Christian Conference Trust at their Suffolk venue, near the Norfolk Broads and the Suffolk Coast. https://www.cct.org.uk/belsey-bridge/belsey-bridge-conference-centre Travel is possible by car with plenty of parking and Norwich Rail Station is just 12 miles. We have reserved 30 places with all ensuite rooms. There is no extra payment for single accommodation.

We anticipate the full cost of the weekend, to include all meals from Friday evening until after lunch on Sunday, dancing and workshops to be approximately £260 per person (less if more people come!). To secure our booking, we need to pay a 20% deposit and so we are asking for an initial payment from you of £50 per person.

We shall welcome non-serTA partners and local teachers on a non-residential basis. It might be possible to book an extra night at the centre to enjoy the beautiful local area.
